# SPREAD HISTORY, NOT GERMS: VISITING THE MUSEUM OF HEALTH CARE AT KINGSTON

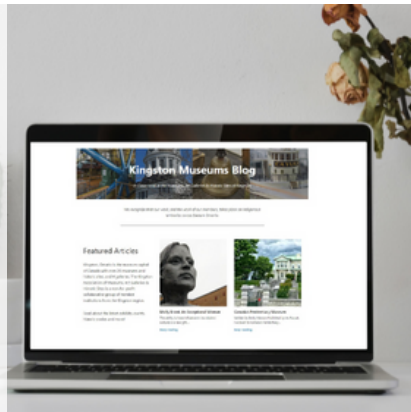
