The Safe Travels Stamp Program

Developed by the World Travel and Tourism Council (WTTC), the #safetravels stamp is a symbol that informs and assures travelers that visitor destinations are implementing standardized health and hygiene protocols. In Ontario, this program is administered by the Tourism Industry Association of Ontario (TIAO) and participation is free. Kingston City Hall, PumpHouse, Kingston Destination Group and Fort Henry have received the stamp. We encourage all of our members to consider applying to the program.
