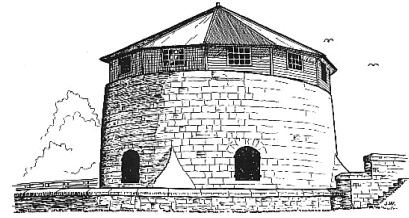

Murney Tower Museum is a small locally-run museum that explores the military history of Kingston and Martello Tower Fortifications. Murney Tower is a part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site of the Rideau Canal and Kingston Fortifications. The Museum offers programming for schools and other special interest groups while serving the local, national and international community.

Description:

The Interpreters will help with the day to day operations at the Museum, including responding to inquiries, light cleaning tasks, admission and tracking finances. Interpreters are the regular onsite staff and will offer tours and public programming to visitors and school groups. Each Interpreter will work with the Museum Committee and Curator to choose a major project for the summer. Must be a student returning to full-time studies in the fall.
